COMMUNITY OF PEACE ACADEMY POLICY No. 4.6.2 BLOODBORNE PATHOGENS

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to direct the administration of Community of Peace Academy to develop procedures to implement OSHA's bloodborne pathogens standards.

II. POLICY STATEMENT

The Board of Community of Peace Academy is committed to full compliance with OSHA's bloodborne pathogens standard and its hazard communications standard.

III. EXPOSURE CONTROL PLAN

To ensure that a healthful work environment is created for staff and students, the administration of Community of Peace Academy is directed to develop an exposure control plan that includes all of the elements required by federal regulations.

IV. HAZARDOUS INFORMATION PLAN

To ensure that information about the dangers of all hazardous chemicals used by Community of Peace Academy is known by all affected employees, administration is directed to develop a hazardous information plan that includes all of the elements required by federal regulations.

V. TIMELINE

Both plans shall be reviewed by the Board of Community of Peace Academy yearly.
